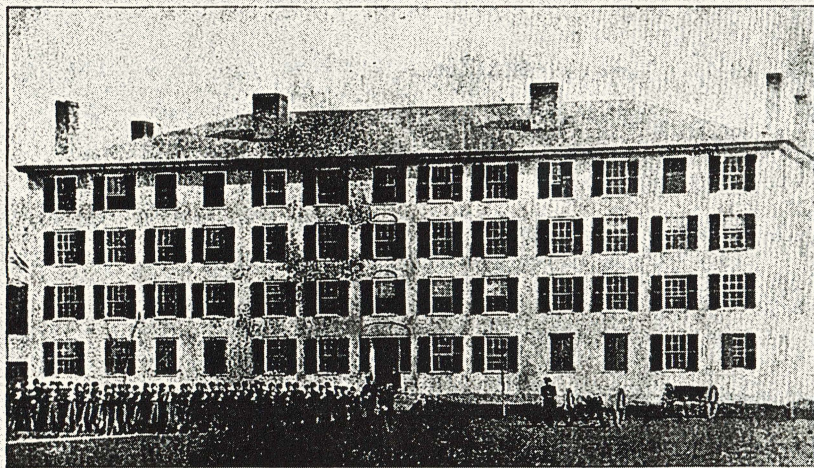

sing our hopes that, bright and free,

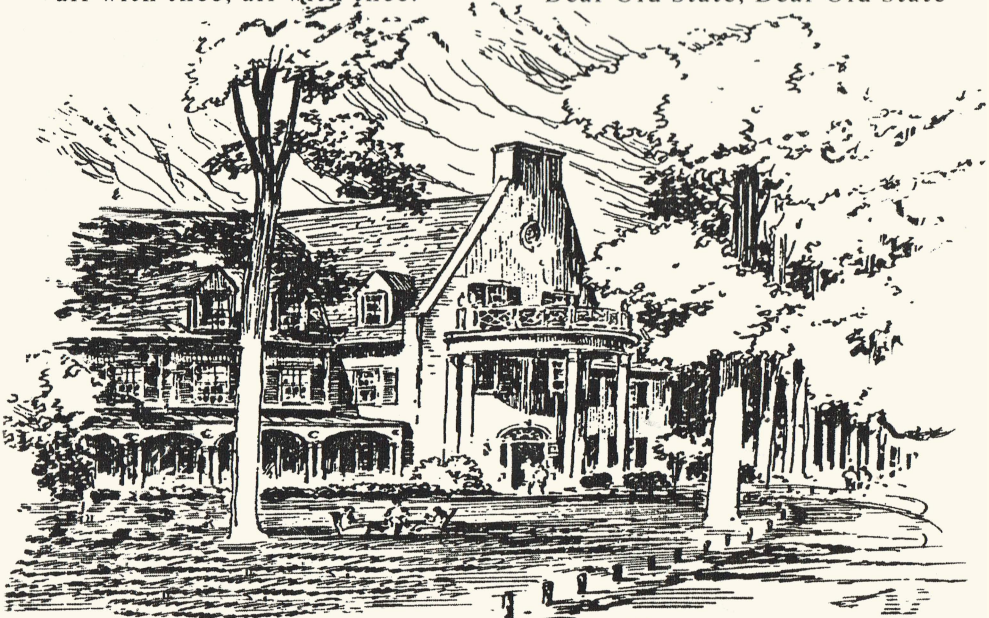
Rest, O Mother, dear, with thee,
